DAY 1 **SATURDAY, JAN 3**



Day 1—United in Prayer

As believers, we unite in prayer, empowered by the Holy Spirit. Our prayers cover families, communities, nations, and urgent global concerns—such as the persecuted Church, humanitarian crises, vulnerable children, and the fight against human trafficking.

VHIM fosters global connections to unite believers in prayer for nations and issues close to our hearts. During this season of consecration, we focus on personal requests and global needs gathered from missionaries, Open Doors (opendoorsuk.org), and Operation World (operationworld.org). This united approach helps us intercede for countries across the globe.



Tip: Whenever possible, pray in the Spirit as you implore these requests.

Consecration Prayer Guide

1. Begin with Praise and Worship

- Jesus Is God: Exalt Jesus, the one true and living God (John 1:14; Hebrews 1:3; Colossians 1:15–20).
- Jesus Our Creator: Magnify Him for His creative power and greatness (Colossians 1:16).
- Worship and Trust: Declare His worthiness and trust Him with your life (Psalm 37:5).

2. Prayer for Self-Examination and Inner Healing

- Personal Desires: Ask, seek, and knock for the desires of your heart (Matthew 7:7-8; 6:33).
- Humility & Submission: Surrender to Jesus as Lord (James 4:10).
- Conviction & Repentance: Invite the Holy Spirit to reveal areas of disobedience and repent (John 16:8).
- **Revelation:** Pray for wisdom and understanding (Ephesians 1:17).
- Forgiveness: Forgive others and celebrate Christ's forgiveness (Ephesians 4:32; Romans 8:1).
- Cleansing & Sanctification: Seek cleansing and holiness (1 John 1:9).
- **Apply the Word:** Pray Scripture over situations (Leviticus 11:44).
- Confession: Confess what the Spirit reveals and accept His forgiveness (1 John 1:9).
- Break Curses: Ask God to reverse curses from sin, trauma, generational issues, or witchcraft.
- Renounce & Remove: Renounce demonic influences and ask the Spirit to remove anything displeasing.
- **Resist Temptation:** Submit to God and resist the devil (James 4:7–8).
- **Refill:** Invite the Holy Spirit to fill every void with His presence, wisdom, and understanding (Ephesians 5:18).

3. Thank God for Forgiveness and the Holy Spirit

- Redemption & Blessing: Thank Jesus for redeeming you from the curse and granting the promise of the Spirit (Galatians 3:13-14).
- Spirit-Filled Boldness: Praise God for filling believers with the Holy Spirit and boldness (Acts 4:31).
- Joy in the Spirit: Celebrate continual joy and fullness in the Holy Spirit (Acts 13:52).
- Spirit's Help in Prayer: Thank Him for the Spirit's intercession when we do not know how to pray (Romans 8:26–28).

DAY 2 SUNDAY, JAN 4

Day 2 — The Body of Christ (Global Church)

Focus: Unity, purity, sound doctrine; bold witness; church planting & evangelism.

Scripture: John 17:21

"That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me."

Prayer for Unity in the Body of Christ

- Seek God's Presence: Acknowledge our need for Him; ask for His will and guidance (1 Chron. 16:11; Ps. 27:8).
- Inner Strength & Unity: Pray for Spirit-empowered love and unity in the gospel (Eph. 3:16; 4:13).
- Commit Plans to God: Trust Him to establish His purposes (Prov. 16:3; Rev. 17:17).
- Christ's Presence & Power: Invite Jesus to manifest His presence among us (Col. 1:17; Matt. 18:20).
- Mission & Evangelism: Seek clarity of vision to make disciples and plant churches (Matt. 28:19–20).
- Harmony & Love: Pray for humility, patience, and unity in the Spirit (Rom. 12:16; Eph. 4:2–3; 1 Cor. 12:25–26).
- Sanctification & Witness: Ask God to purify His Church and make us a light to the world (Eph. 5:25–27; Matt. 5:14–16; Acts 1:8).
- Wisdom to Unite: Lay aside differences and focus on Christ (Eph. 4:4–6; 1 Cor. 12:4–7).
- Forgiveness & Love: Forgive others, renounce bitterness, and walk in love (Eph. 4:32; Matt. 6:14–15; Heb. 12:15).
- Godly Thoughts: Fix minds on truth, purity, and love (Phil. 4:8; Col. 3:1–2; 2 Cor. 10:5).
- Renew First Love: Repent of complacency and seek wholehearted devotion to Jesus (Rev. 2:4–5; Mark 12:30).
- True Worship: Worship in Spirit and truth, grounded in God's Word (John 4:23–24; Rom. 12:1; Ps. 100:1–5).
- ✓ The Word of God is living and active—meditate on it as you pray for unity and mission.

DAY 3 MONDAY, JAN 5

Day 3 — Invite the Holy Spirit to Prepare and Equip You for Service Scriptures:

• Ephesians 4:11-12 — Christ equips His people for ministry and building up the Body.

- Romans 8:26-28 The Spirit intercedes for us in our weakness.
- Philippians 3:10 "That I may know Him, and the power of His resurrection..."
- Acts 17:28 "For in Him we live, and move, and have our being."

Intimacy and Oneness with the Holy Spirit

- Welcome His Presence: Invite the Holy Spirit to intercede and pray His will through you.
- **Deepen Connection**: Spend time in His presence; seek intimacy and oneness.
- **Discernment & Revelation**: Ask for clarity, spiritual insight, and divine wisdom.
- Guidance & Rhema Word: Pray for direction and understanding of His work globally.
- **Deliverance**: Ask for freedom from obstacles hindering your service.
- Personal Prayer: "Lord, I desire to know You more deeply and love You more intensely."

Alive in Christ — Equipped for Service

- Thank God for life, protection, and provision (Acts 17:28).
- Pray:
 - o "Lord Jesus, use my life as a vessel to extend Your Gospel."
 - o "Guide me to share my journey to lead others to You."
 - o "Empower me to be a beacon of Your love in my community."
- Pray for God's goodness to touch your neighbors and city through your actions.
- Pray for your church to reflect God's love and light (Matt. 5:14).
- ✓ Focus today on intimacy with the Spirit and readiness for service—He equips you for every good work.

DAY 4 TUESDAY, JAN 6



Day 4 — Prayer for Family and Community

Focus: Healing in homes; peace; mutual support; local outreach.

Scripture: Joshua 24:15 — "...as for me and my house, we will serve the LORD."

Pray for Family, Neighbors, and Community

- Ask God to speak through you as His image-bearer.
- Pray for unity, peace, and well-being in your home and neighborhood (Jer. 29:7).

Church's Impact

- Pray for your church to influence the community with the Gospel.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to stir up gifts within you and remove hindrances.

Remember: Your gifts are God's hands at work (Matt. 5:16).

Pray for the Lost

- Intercede for lost souls; ask the Spirit to reveal hearts ready for salvation.
- Pray for God's light to shine and draw them to Christ.

Personal Reflection

- "Jesus, help me see Your image in every person I meet."
- "Lord, unite us in love to transform our communities."
- "Help us reflect Your image by loving, serving, sowing, and giving generously."
- **Remember:** "The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective" (James 5:16).

DAY 5 WEDNESDAY, JAN 7

Day 5 — Pray for Youth & Young Adults

Scripture: Psalm 91:11 – "For He shall give His angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways."

Focus: Hope in Christ; protection from unhealthy media; mental health; wisdom; resilience.

Youth (Ages 10-19)

Scripture: Proverbs 4:23 – "Keep thy heart with all diligence; for out of it are the issues of life."

- **Mental Health Crisis**: Globally, 1 in 7 adolescents (14%) experience mental health disorders; in the U.S., over 20% of teens had a major depressive episode in 2021, with female youth nearly three times more affected than males. [therapyroute.com], [therapyroute.com]
- **Self-Harm & Anxiety**: In 2023, over 40% of U.S. high-school students reported persistent sadness or hopelessness; self-harm ER visits doubled among 12–17-year-olds. [mtppsychiatry.com], [psychreg.org]
- **Social Media Use**: U.S. teens average 7 hours 22 minutes daily on screens; globally, social media use is 2h 41m, with Gen Z spending 3h 18m online daily. [pewresearch.org], [explodingtopics.com], [sqmagazine.co.uk]
- **Academic Stress**: 91% of students report stress; 60% in chronic stress daily; 44% of college students report depression, 41% anxiety; 77% of high-schoolers have poor sleep. [keevee.com], [essaypro.com], [hillsidehorizon.com]
- **Substance Use**: 91% of 8th-graders and 66% of 12th-graders abstain from alcohol, marijuana, and nicotine; about 9% of youth aged 12–17 had a substance use disorder in 2023. [nih.gov], [southdenve...herapy.com], [drugabuses...istics.org]

Young Adults (Ages 18-24)

Scripture: James 1:5 – "If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God..."

- Mental Health & Identity: 36% report anxiety; 29% report depression; nearly 60% feel a lack of meaning in life. [therapyroute.com], [southdenve...herapy.com]
- Economic Struggles: Over one-third of 18–24-year-olds had no wage income in 2022. [drugabuses...istics.org], [addictiongroup.org]
- Substance Use: CDC reports 34–39% used illicit drugs in the past year; binge drinking is highest among this group. [addictiongroup.org], [samhsa.gov]

Prayer Points

- Mental Health: "Lord, heal youth from depression, anxiety, hopelessness, and self-harm. Surround them with hope."
- **Protection from Media Negative Impact**: "Shield them from harmful content; fill them with your Spirit (Gal. 5:22–23); guide them to uplifting, godly influences."
- Academic Stress: "Calm anxious hearts, restore rest, and grant wisdom under pressure."
- Substance Use: "Deliver those experimenting or struggling; strengthen them to choose life in Jesus."
- Spiritual Growth: "Grant wisdom (James 1:5), reveal identity in Christ, open their hearts to God's calling, and fill them with His Spirit (Eph. 1:18–19)."
- Young Adults: "Provide purpose, stability, healthy relationships, and wisdom. Break addiction and anxiety; guide them in truth (John 8:32; 16:13)."
- Protection & Guidance: "Send your angels to guard their ways (Psalm 91:11)."

DAY 6 THURSDAY, JAN 8

Day 6— Serving the Kingdom: Short-Term & Long-Term Missions

The Sutherlands - Liberty International Learning Center

Prayer Focus: Ministry in Benin & Beyond

Benin – Urgent

- **Political Stability:** 2026 is an election year starting in January. On December 7, a military coup attempt failed, but there are rumors of another possible strike. Pray for lasting peace in Benin.
- **Voodoo Festival:** January 8–10 marks the Voodoo celebration holiday. Formerly a one-day national holiday, it has expanded to three days as the nation promotes Voodoo as a tourism attraction. Voodoo is now taught as a "science" in public schools. Pray against spiritual darkness, especially during these days.
- Parliamentary Elections: January 11 is the parliamentary election (similar to Congress). Pray for godly, righteous leaders to be elected and for peace without violence.
- Ask God to bring peace and protection to **Northern Benin** and its vulnerable communities.

Children's Outreach & Education - Ongoing

- Pray for vulnerable children in Benin, where 46% of the population is under 14. Ask God to provide food, healthcare, education, and protection from malnutrition and trafficking.
- Pray for the Gloria Sutherland Children's Fund, supporting up to 600 children in spiritual, educational, health, and social development.

- Praise God for the Village Library. Continue to pray for the upkeep of the newly built library and provision of books and supplies to help children grow academically and spiritually.
- Pray for wisdom in assisting the primary school. Teachers lack materials and classrooms are overcrowded. We are seeking basic reading resources for grades 1–6 to supplement the Village Library.

Women's Empowerment - Ongoing

• Pray for programs that equip women through literacy, professional development, business skills, health awareness, and prayer.

Village Transformation & Economic Development - Ongoing

- Pray for Anagbo's complete transformation from Voodoo practices to serving Jesus Christ, becoming a model for other villages.
- Pray for modern agricultural equipment to replace outdated tools, so children can attend school instead of working in fields.
- Pray for wisdom in ministering to villages in the Tchachou region of North Benin.

Literacy Program - Ongoing

- Pray for increased literacy (currently 38.4%) so people can read the Bible and grow in faith.
- Ask God to raise up more teachers for the literacy program to prevent mixing Christianity with idolatry. We have four committed teachers, but need six more. Pray for the successful recruitment of teachers and students this January.

Discipleship & Leadership Development - Ongoing

- Pray for the Bible Institute and Life Empowerment programs that disciple believers and train leaders to transform communities.
- Ask for financial provision for ongoing training and for leaders to multiply disciples for God's Kingdom.

Direction & Guidance – Urgent

- Pray that we hear clearly from the Holy Spirit and receive direction for 2026.
- Ask for wisdom, strength, and endurance to fulfill the Lord's instructions.

International Residency & Travel - Ongoing

- Praise God for granting the Sutherlands residency in Benin. Pray for the successful registration of the ministry LILC in Benin.
- Pray for safe travels to India and other countries for ministry.

Resources & Growth - Ongoing

- Pray for continued provision—people and finances—to sustain and expand the ministry.
- Pray for missionaries to be raised up for Benin and India.
- Pray for individuals with administrative skills to assist the ministry.

Ministry in India – Ongoing

- Pray for the development of a small group of leaders in India to share the Gospel.
- Pray for expedited approval of long-term residency. It is illegal in India for foreigners to preach, convert, or engage in missionary work.

General Ministry Needs – Ongoing

• Pray for God's guidance, provision, protection, favor, and strength for The Sutherlands and all ministry partners.

Scripture:

- Pray for unity among branches of government and divine integrity in decision-making.

Military & Security

- Pray for protection and courage for U.S. forces worldwide.

Day 10 — Pray for Africa



Focus: Peace amid conflicts; food security; stewardship; protection of believers.

Scripture: Isaiah 61:4 — "And they shall build the old wastes... and repair the waste cities..."

• Peace & Displacement

- *Conflict hotspots:* Ongoing violence in Sudan, Ethiopia, Sahel; African-wide, nearly 10% of the population regularly faces political violence. [futures.is...africa.org]
- Humanitarian crisis: Sudan conflict has displaced 12.8 million people, with some 400,000 killed. [africacenter.org]

Food Security



 - o Includes refugees, asylum seekers, and internally displaced people.
- **Resettlement Needs**: U.S. Refugee Admissions Program (USRAP) continues to provide pathways for those fleeing persecution based on race, religion, nationality, social group, or political opinion.

Prayer Points

- Leaders & Policies: Wisdom and compassion for U.S. leaders shaping refugee policies.
- **Support & Integration**: Access to housing, education, and employment for refugees.
- Protection & Safety: Security for displaced persons during resettlement.
- Community Response: Open hearts and practical support from local communities.
- Hunger & Displacement: For those unfed and far from home.

- Persecution & Conflict: Safety for those escaping violence and exploitation.
- Heart of Love: Inspire compassion and generosity toward the homeless and displaced.

May God guide and protect all seeking refuge and bless efforts to provide safety and hope.

DAY 12 WEDNESDAY, JAN 14

Day 12: The Poor, Marginalized, Disadvantaged, Lonely, and Afflicted

Focus: Relief, justice, dignity, community, and deliverance.

Scripture: Proverbs 19:17

"He that hath pity upon the poor lendeth unto the LORD; and that which he hath given will he pay him again."

Current Situation in the U.S. & Globally (2025)

- Poverty:
 - o About 37.9 million people live below the poverty line (U.S. Census Bureau, 2024).

- Global Poverty:
- Over 700 million people live in extreme poverty (less than \$2.15/day) worldwide (World Bank, 2024).

- 3. Commit to Ongoing Rhythms: Dedicate yourself to continued prayer, fasting, and service in 2026.
- 4. Seek God's Will: Ask: What is God's will for my life? Am I willing to follow His command regarding global needs?
- 5. **Call to Ministry:** Pray about whether God is calling you to pray, support, or go to the nations for Him.

Scripture Reminders

- Revelation 22:20: "Come, Lord Jesus."
- 2 Peter 3:12 (ESV): "Wait for and hasten the coming of the day of God."
- Genesis 12:3; Revelation 7:9–10; Matthew 24:14: Pray for the fulfillment of God's promise to bless all nations and for the Gospel to reach every people group.
